Slavco Sokolovski is a painter, object, and installation artist. He graduated from faculty of Fine Art in Skopje, Macedonia in 1986. His work has been shown throughout former Yugoslavia in cities including Skopje, Belgrade, Novi Sad, Zagreb, Ljubljana, Rijeka, and Sarajevo, in addition to Rome, Paris, London, Nuremberg, Dresden, Berlin, St. Petersburg, Washington, D.C. Boston, New York, and Los Angeles. He has received numerous awards for excellence in painting in Macedonia, where his artwork is part of public and private collections. His artwork is also part of more dozen private collections in Boston, New York, London, Washington, D.C., Los Angeles, and Santa Fe. He lives and works in Cambridge, Massachusetts.
